

5 RESOURCES FOR SHORT TERM HOUSING

TOOLS FOR A TRAVELING HEALTHCARE PROVIDER

FURNISHED FINDER

Furnished Finder is an online platform for travel healthcare providers to find short term housing.

Pros: Exactly what you're looking for! A lot of landlords are HC workers, fair prices, search through filters.

Cons: Website is not user friendly making it difficult to correspond through the platform.



AIR BNB

Airbnb is more commonly known for short vacations but some hosts allow long term stays!

Pros: Filter every need, see reviews.

Cons: Full rent is due unless otherwise discussed, extra fees for taxes and cleaning. More money to rent and paying upfront.



TRAVEL HC GROUPS

Search "travel [HC] housing" on Facebook most people offering their space don't care if you're a nurse, PT student or otherwise as long as you're upfront.

Pros: Scope out their profile! Search exact locations through the magnifying glass icon.

Cons: It's best to ask for links to safe sites (FF or airbnb) for photos and rent so you don't get scammed!



PT STUDENT GROUPS

The Doctor of Physical Therapy Student page on Facebook had an excel doc to both post your housing needs or availability.

Pros: Renting from other DPT students or their families, priced fairly, like-minded roommates!

Cons: Updated infrequently, sometimes it works better just to post a need on the forum itself.



CLIN-ED TEAM

Classmates, teachers, and the clinical rotation/job you're going to may be of help.

Pros: Large network of people, past student advice, or your admin may be able to reach out to the rotation directly to spread the word to students nearby.

Cons: Not always an option!
